BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, that Chapter 110, Article 3, §3.3.1, of the Code of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, is hereby amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, that Chapter 110, Article 3, §3.5.3, of the Code of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, is hereby amended as follows:

- §3.5. Specific Use Standards
- §3.5.3. Commercial use standards

I. Urban agriculture

- 1. All growing and production activities shall be conducted wholly within a fully enclosed structure or on the rooftop of a structure.
- 2. Urban agriculture shall not include the keeping of animals, except as accessory to the principal use, such as for aquaponics.
- 3. Waste handling and ventilation on the subject property shall be designed to substantially control odors discernable off-site.
- 4. In commercial districts, for facilities located on the ground floor of a building, 25 percent of the building frontage associated with the subject use must be dedicated to retail purposes.

IJ. Vehicle sales and leasing

6. Each vehicle on such lot not parked upon a parking space meeting the requirements of §4.2, or within a structure, shall be screened in accordance with §3.5.3.I.5 §3.5.3.J.5, above.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, that Chapter 110, Article 4, §4.2.3, of the Code of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, is hereby amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, that Chapter 110, Article 9, §9.3, of the Code of the City of Fairfax, Virginia, is hereby amended as follows:

§9.3. Defined Terms

• • • •

URBAN AGRICULTURE: An establishment for the cultivation, retail sales and distribution of agricultural products where such activity takes place within a fully enclosed structure or on the rooftop of a structure. Urban agriculture may include, but is not limited to aeroponics, hydroponics, vertical farming and related agricultural methods. The definition of urban agriculture shall not include establishments that cultivate cannabis.
